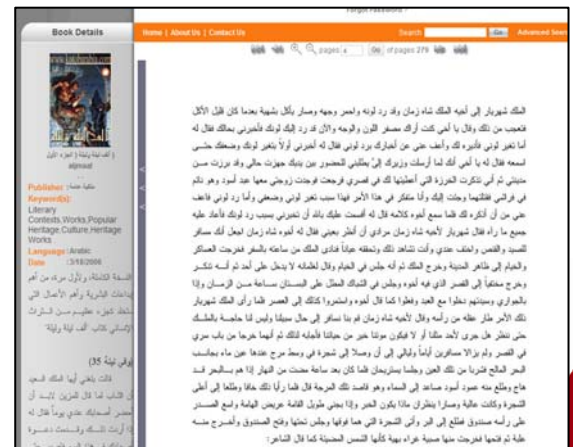
Arranged thematically and with accompanying MARC records, Kotobarabia puts an electronically searchable library of contemporary and classic writing at your fingertips.
