Modern China Databank, 1977-2005

Founded in 1977 by the Historical Commission of the Kuomintang Party, Modern China is a resource for the history of the Republic of China, the Revolutionary Martyrs archives, and Revolutionary documents of China.

While other historic academic journals of its kind focus on discourse and commentary, Modern China published first-hand historic materials from the Kuomintang authorities, revealing the "oral history" of the most important figures of the Republic's history, and combines archives and historic research not found anywhere else.

More than 5,000 articles covering 49,300 figures and 40,520 historical events

Modern China also sponsored international academic seminars, covered in the journal, with participants from mainland China, North and South Korea, Japan, Hong Kong, in addition to Taiwan.
