Platform: CNKI China Government Gazettes (CGGD) is an authoritative collection of political newspapers, bulletins, announcements, and other official regulations, proclamations, and research. CGGD is a standardized one-stop search tool for central and local government publications including laws and regulations, government and department work reports, government white papers, speeches, personnel appointments and removals, cases and judicial interpretations, international conventions, and more. Containing 224 total kinds of official bulletins and almost 600,000 articles, sources in CGGD include political newspapers, bulletins, announcements, and proclamation journals sponsored by people's congresses, national and local governments, courts, procuratorates, and various industries and organizations that have legislative powers throughout China. Subjects covered by CGGD include politics, law, military and national defense, rural management and agriculture, industry, transportation, finance, education, science and technology, tourism, and more.

#### Content

- CGGD features a variety of resources:
  - 224 total kinds of official bulletins
  - 23 communiques of central ministries and commissions
  - · 200 local government newspapers and bulletins
  - Almost 600.000 total articles
- CGGD includes content from such publishing agencies as the National People's Congress, Party Central Committee, State Council and subordinate departments, military institutions, banks, and associations, as well as regional agencies.

#### **Functions**

- Navigation: Browse titles by subject, publishing agency, document type, geography, and source.
- Search: Search multiple fields including journal title, subject, full text, date, ISSN, CN, and issue number.
- Knowledge networks: CNKI's Knowledge Network Node supports discovery of additional related content with tools such as similar documents and document classification navigation.
