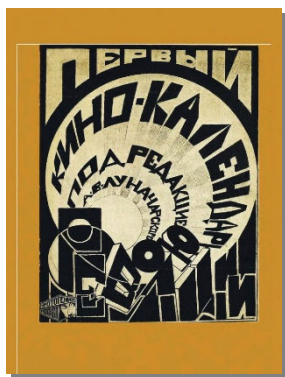


Early Soviet Cinema
